### Native Shrubs:

<b>American Hazelnut</b> <i>Corylus americana</i>	2-year seedlings, 12 to 18 inches	Height 12 feet. Prefers moist, well drained soils but will adapt to most types of soil. Full to partial sun. Attracts deer, grouse, turkeys, pheasants and quail.	\$1.75 each seedling (75 available)
<b>Highbush Cranberry</b> <i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	8 to 15 inches	Height 8 to 12 feet. Blooms May to June. Well drained to moist soil and full to partial sun.	\$1.75 each seedling (50 available)
<b>Maple Leaf Viburnum</b> <i>Viburnum acerifolium</i>	3-year plug	Height 6 to 8 feet with at least a 4-foot spread. Multi stemmed shrub that prefers partial sun to shade in most well drained soils.	\$4.00 each plug (63 available)
<b>New Jersey Tea</b> <i>Ceanothus americanus</i>	Small pot	Height and width 3 to 4 feet. Compact & rounded. Full or part sun and medium dry soil. Often browsed by wildlife so needs protection while young.	\$3.25 per pot (38 available)
<b>Nannyberry</b> <i>Viburnum lentago</i>	1-year seedling, 12 to 18 inches	Height 15 feet. Spreads by suckers. Full to partial sun. Adapts to dry to moist well drained sites.	\$1.75 each seedling (50 available)
<b>Ninebark</b> <i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i>	24 to 48 inches	Height 5 to 9 feet and 6-foot spread. Full sun to partial shade. Tolerates a variety of soils.	\$1.75 each seedling (50 available)
<b>Red Osier Dogwood</b> <i>Cornus sericea</i>	2-year seedlings, 12 to 24 inches	Height 7 to 9 feet and spread 8 to 12 feet. Full to partial sun. Prefers moist soil.	\$0.75 each seedling (75 available)

<b>Serviceberry/Downy</b> <i>Amelanchier arborea</i>	1-year nursery & 12 to 24 inches	Height 15 to 25 feet. Full to partial sun. Multi-stemmed that prefers moist well drained soil and flowers mid-May.	\$1.50 each seedling (50 available)

<b>Bur Oak</b> <i>Quercus macrurcarpa</i>	1-year seedling, 12 to 18 inches	Height 70 to 80 feet. Does well in a variety of soil conditions. Full sun.	\$1.75 each seedling (25 available)
<b>Swamp White Oak</b> <i>Quercus bicolor</i>	2-year seedling, 12 to 18 inches	Height 50 to 60 feet. Does well in moist to wet soils as well as upland soils. Their acorns are great for wildlife.	\$1.75 each seedling (25 available)
